The Chief Steward and judge, at their discretion, may refuse to award any prize, due to inferior quality of any exhibit or lack of numbers in a class.

No second prize will be awarded unless there are 3 or more entries.

Goods donated to the Show Society will be marked as entries are received.

Any items not collected on Sunday after the Show will become the property of the Show Society

1. Barley, bushel sample, malting variety
2. Wheat, bushel sample, any variety
3. Oats, bushel sample, any variety
4. Grain Sorghum (grain), bushel, any variety
5. Grain Sorghum (heads), 4 heads, any variety
6. Maize (green in stalk), 4 stalks, any variety to be shown with dobs
7. Maize (grain) bushel, any variety
8. Hay, wheaten (bale as from baler - to be at least 22kg)
9. Hay, lucerne (bale as from baler - to be at least 22kg)
10. Sunflower, best 2 heads
11. Chaff, oaten (1 bag not less than 9kg)
12. Chaff, Lucerne (1 bag not less than 9kg)
13. Chaff, wheaten (1 bag not less than 9kg)
14. Lucerne, green, 1 bundle (not less than 7kg)
15. Hammermilled mixture - 1 bushel
16. Maize, 4 cobs, any variety
17. Lucerne seed, 2.2kg
18. Sunflower seeds, 2.2kg
19. Cow pumpkin with stalk
