PLEASE NOTE: Our committee request that all information relating to an animal's pedigree and NLIS information be submitted as per requested on the entry form. We are now required to submit NVD's and NLIS/RFID numbers for all animals being exhibited, therefore we have now included a space in entry form for this information.

National Cattle Health Statements & NVD's and ENTRY FEES to be received **PRIOR** to receiving neck cards.

Entry Fee: \$10 per head (no entry fee for Group Classes)

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Each exhibitor must state on the entry form the class number in which the animal is entered, and PEDIGREE DETAILS of each animal entered – as requested on the entry form
- In Stud classes all cattle must be registered with their Breed Society
- The ages of stud beef cattle to be the actual age up and to and inclusive of 1st February next. An animal born after 1st February of the preceding year will be eligible for the not over 12-month class
- No late entries will be accepted, and no entry fee will be refunded.
- All entries from any individual class to be eligible to compete in group classes
- Cow and calf entries will be deemed as one entry. Calves at foot MUST be under 9 months on 1st February 2026. CALF cannot be shown as an individual in Saturday classes; HOWEVER, heifer calves may be shown in 8–12-month class as individuals in the Friday night Heifer Show
- Neck straps are compulsory on all cattle when not in the control of an attendant
- Paraders to wear breed uniform or dust coats
- All animals being paraded on the showground must have strong halters and nose lead always attached
- ALL ANIMALS being shown in the ring must have a nose ring or nose dogs as per the following: All BULLS twelve months and over to have nose rings, bulls under 12 months either nose ring or nose dogs and ALL FEMALES must have either nose ring or nose dogs, exhibitors must comply with this rule, or you will be asked to remove animals from ring.
- All bulls must be led in classes by experienced exhibitors OVER THE AGE OF 16 years
- No animal to be paraded in the ring to be led by anyone under the age of 7 years.
- Bulls not eligible to be led in the Paraders Competition on Friday Night
- No animals will be allowed in the judging ring without a breast plate number
- Each exhibitor must state the number if animals intended for exhibit for stall allocation
- In the case of withdrawals substitute entries can be made, but only in that case
- The Chief Steward must be advised on arrival at the ground of any substitutes for alteration to catalogue
- It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to ensure that the leaders of their stock in judging rings parader's or elsewhere on the ground can exercise control over animals in their care. The stewards reserve the right to have any animal removed from the judging ring, main arena, or other

- areas, if in their opinion such an animal is classed as dangerous, intractable or is disadvantaging other exhibits.
- The Society has the right to be sole arbitrator in relation to all disputes, omissions, acts etc and as such decisions shall be final and binding upon all persons affected therein
- In any class an award may only be made at the discretion of the Judges
- Trucks to unloaded, then immediately moved to a designated parking area.
- Breast Plates are available on the day.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to put all NLIS/RFID numbers of all exhibits on Entry Form
- Steer Section if exhibitors could get an approximate weight of their steer/fat heifer prior to
 entering so we can place animals in appropriate weight range class rather than having an Open
 and School Steer Class we will try and have weight range classes
